Please make sure that your child's planner comes to school each day and please write any messages you need to pass on to us.

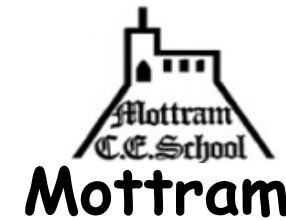
