Well done to the football team who won 9-4 against Linden Road.

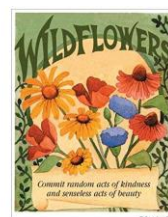


Special thanks to Mrs Brereton and Mr Chatterton for organising the event.
