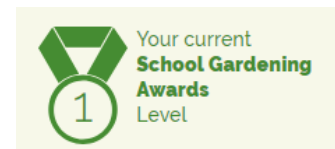

Great News! Our Eco Team have achieved Level 1. The children submitted a short-written piece on their future gardening plans. This was their submission:

Our future gardening plans are to create a wildlife area in our school grounds.

We will grow pollen and nectar-rich plants to attract bees, butterflies and other insects. We want to conserve and protect our wildlife as they play an important role pollinating our plants.

We will work with younger children in school to make mini-beast homes to encourage wildlife to the garden by providing shelter for the insects we attract. This will help to keep our garden's eco-system healthy.

The children have already been working with Reception class to make bird feeders and weather dependant the Eco Team will be out later this week with Purple Class taking part in the 'Big Schools' Birdwatch'. Keep up the good work!
