# What's happening

#### Michael Forman retires

Michael Forman the chair and founder of Tameside South and Longdendale Foodbank retired this month. He has facilitated the foodbank giving out **151,671** meals. This has helped so many people through difficult times, keeping families together, preventing eviction and keeping them out of debt. We will miss him.

We hope that he and his wife Elizabeth enjoy their retirement. They have been invited to a royal garden party at Buckingham Palace because of his work at Cheshire East Foodbank—we hope that they have a wonderful day and send us some photographs.



Trussell Trust have set-up an agreement with ASDA stores that means that we have started to collect

food in ASDA Hyde. There is now a permanent trolley in the foyer for donations and we had our first "buy an extra can for the foodbank" collection under the agreement last month. In all ASDA shoppers have given 6,507 meals since the scheme started in June 2018. Thank-you to shoppers and staff who made the collection such a success.



## **Easter School Holiday Meals**

This Easter we will be providing food parcels to families at local primary schools. Many families struggle over the holiday period when the kids do not receive a

school dinner. Nationally almost 1 in 4 parents with children aged 18 and under are skipping meals because of lack of money. We estimate that we will have to provide up to 75 parcels—which adds up to almost 2,500 meals. Hopefully we will have enough Easter eggs to go round. Thank-you to the local primary schools at Pinfold, St James', Arundale and Mottram who help us circulating invitations and vouchers to their parents.
