Dear Parent/Carer

We are delighted to welcome you back and look forward to working with all our new families.

As Government guidelines state we no longer need to impose certain restrictions, therefore, face masks are no longer mandatory outside the school premises, and we will be removing the one-way system. We appreciate that face masks are a personal choice so if you wish to wear one as there will be more parents and carers on the playground, please feel free to continue to do so.

We will no longer be having a staggered start or finish time; this means we will open the gates at 8:50am and the children can enter the building to get settled into class before lessons begin. School gates will be locked at 9:00am, so if you arrive after 9:00am please ensure your child enters the school through the front door. School will finish at 3:15pm for all pupils

Unfortunately, the roofing was not completed over the summer holidays, but should be due to finish very soon (we are hoping this Friday!). Therefore, can we please ask that on Thursday and Friday this week, Purple Class and Yellow Class children will need to enter the building via the KS2 entrance. At the end of the day, teachers will dismiss the children via the main entrance for ease. We have been informed that this is only for this week but if we need to continue next week, we will of course communicate this to you. We apologise in advance for this inconvenience but hopefully the roof will now be watertight.

We have also enclosed an area specifically for Early Years for continuous provision which means that if you decide to exit the building next to Reception Class you will have to walk through their area. This is absolutely fine and will remain this way until the new exit to the building is built further down the playground.
