This is a team of professionals within the National Health Service in the UK, working with practitioners to develop new resources to support emotional health and well-being for children, families, adults and older adults.

The Ambassadors of the school have been very busy! The Health and Wellbeing Champions have read stories to each class and are currently working on a session for staff. The School Council have made posters illustrating that all are welcome at Mottram, following on from our 'No Outsiders' collective worships.
