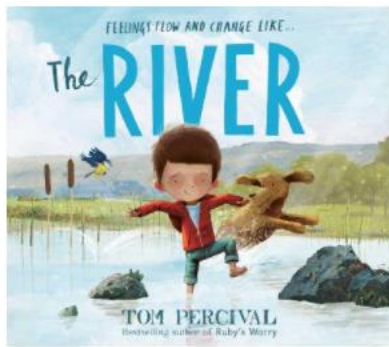

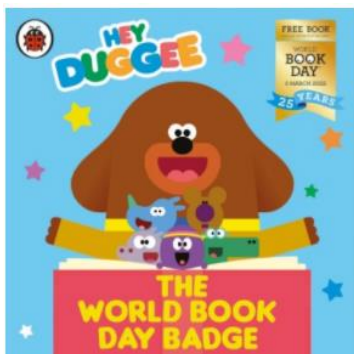


The River

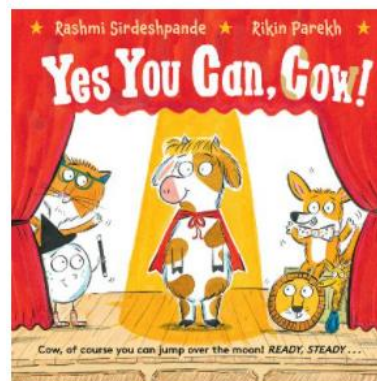

A gorgeous, heart-warming story about believing in yourself and doing your best based on the ever-popular nursery rhyme 'Hey Diddle Diddle'.

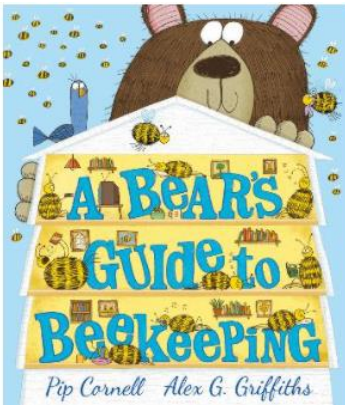

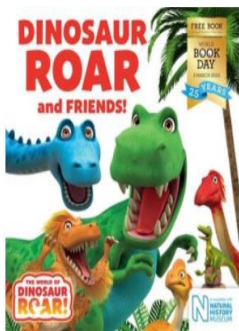
Big Green Crocodile
