**A Child's War**

**Outcome:**

Develop children's knowledge of what it was like to be evacuated and live with a family other than our own. From a range of maps, we'll identify safe and dangerous places during the war, which will make us think about the consequences of war. We'll learn about the celebrations that marked the end of the war.
