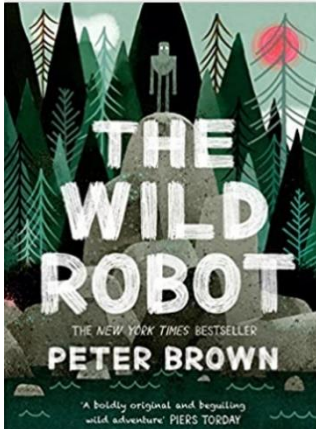
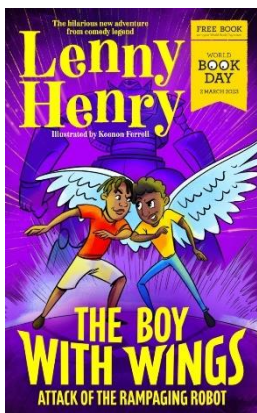

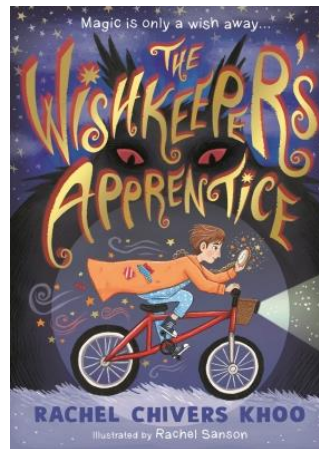
Oh yeah, Tunde is *also* a secret superhero.

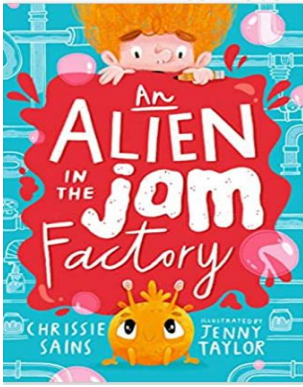

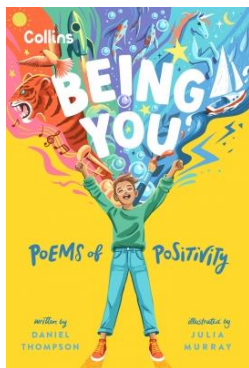

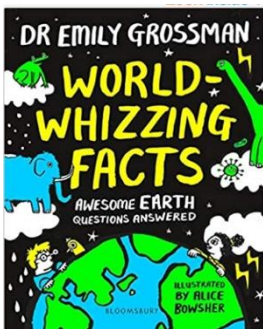
