Topic Theme and Golden Thread

As a Victorian child, what toys would I have played with?

Outcome: In this unit, children will be exploring their own memories and will learn about their family and younger children. They will also learn about changes in technology and significant individuals who have had an impact on this. The children will explore the local area in Geography conducting their own fieldwork and learning how to use compass directions.
